ORLANDO, FLORIDA — Regal Marine, one of the nation's largest privately owned boat building companies, annually asks its 600 employees to grade and evaluate all benefits the company offers. In the most recent team member's benefit survey, the Employee Care Program provided by Marketplace Chaplains USA, was selected as the #1 benefit. Three out of four workers judged the Chaplain Care Teams' services the very best benefit provided by the company. Chaplains caring for workers and their families were chosen ahead of health insurance, retirement funding, educational scholarships and 11 other benefits.
